

Can the battery cabinet be touched by hand



Overview

Generally, it's safe to do so, but you're only allowed to touch the case, battery label, one terminal only, and when the battery is not connected to the device. What if the battery leaks by hand?

That's because it's known that not all battery surfaces can be touched safely and willingly. It's known that some parts of the battery have a large electrical conductivity level, so touching it directly can potentially have a high risk to safety compared to when you touch the battery case or outer. Let's set the record straight: you can indeed touch car battery terminals with your hand. Someone must still work on or maintain the battery system. Working on a battery should always be considered energized. Battery Rooms Spark generating parts must have a distance to cell/block openings (respectively valves) of at least 0.
