Your new TV is all plugged in and ready to go when you realize the remote doesn't have batteries installed. Fitting your batteries into the remote can feel like a puzzle, leaving you unsure where each battery end goes. Look for a plus symbol on your battery. The polarity of batteries is what helps them supply current to a device. The plus sign, or "+," indicates the positive terminal. On AA. Look at the snaps on top of the 9-Volt battery. A 9V battery is small and square, with two snaps on the top. One is a male connector, and the other is female. Examine the face of the battery for a "+" symbol.
