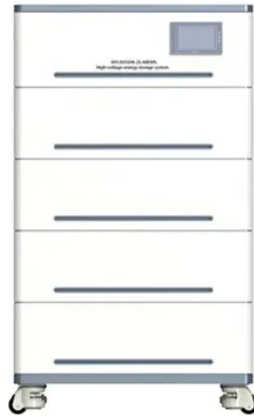


Reykjavik green electricity
