The Kolda project will encompass a 60MWp PV. Senegal has signed two key agreements with Chinese state-owned firm CNTIC to boost its solar energy and digital infrastructure. The deal includes the construction of two 50 MWp photovoltaic solar power plants, each paired with a 30 MW / 90 MWh battery storage system, to support the country's rural. The vertically integrated and state-owned electric utility, SENELEC, maintains a monopoly in transmission and distribution (outside certain rural zones where private concessions are allowed) and is the main counterpart to IPPs for power purchase agreements (PPAs).
