The circuits are distributed through this subpanel and is also where my solar system feeds back into the grid through 2 separate circuits (220V). The solar system is a 4.4KW system installed which utilizes 2 strings of Enphase MicroInverters each feeding into the aforementioned main distribution panel.

Backfeeding SubPanels from Solar Arrays

The panels will be approximately 180" from my main service meter (and main service panel). The main service panel is a 200 amp service, with a 60 amp breaker that feeds a 200 amp sub-panel in the shop near where the solar panels will be installed. I believe the copper feeding the subpanel is #4 or #6, but I'll have to verify for sure.

Line side tap with battery.

Line side taps can create a challenge on the battery side. Essentially there are 2 challenges 1) When the power down you need to cut off the grid to prevent backfeeding. 2) You need a path to get the power from the batteries to the house, without go to the grid.

Between 12000XP and Main Panel: does not have N-N or G-G; When the 12000XP is in grid bypass mode, pulling 100A from the Main Panel and sending it to the Subpanel, the Subpanel to Main Panel N-N and G-G connection will function as the 12000XP's connection to the Main Panel's neutral and ground.

Load sharing between grid and inverter

Kirchoff's current law says 1A must flow out of "main panel". So where is that current going to flow? Answer: toward "the grid" Scenario 2: PV produces 10A which flows toward the node we'll call "main panel" 12A flows out toward "local load" Kirchoff's current law says 2A must flow in to "main panel".
