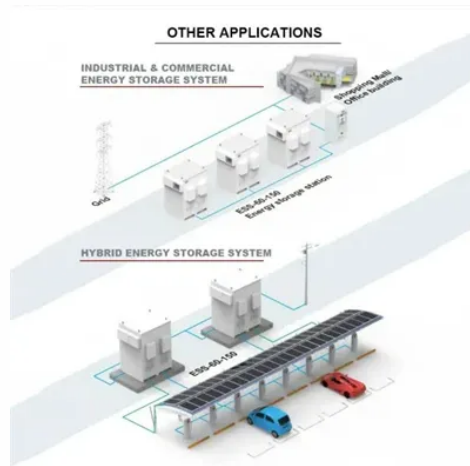


Solar power panel does not light up automatically
